Status of CLE Approvals by State

The HCCA submits sessions deemed eligible for general CLE credits and legal ethics CLE credits to most states with CLE approval processes for sponsors. Exceptions are noted below. CLE credits are awarded based on state CLE rules and individual attendance. Please note that approvals will vary as each state may have different CLE requirements, rules, and regulations:

- ⚠️ **Not every state calculates CLE credits based on the clock (60-minute) hour.**
- ⚠️ **Not every state will grant general CLE credits for all sessions submitted by the HCCA.**
- ⚠️ **Not every state will grant legal ethics CLE credits for all sessions submitted by the HCCA.**
